From the beginning of Term 1 2023, COVID-smart measures developed with NSW Health to minimise transmission and keep schools open, will continue to be in place. These key measures include:

- Reminding students, staff and families to stay home if unwell and test for COVID-19 if showing any symptoms
- Boosted day cleaning of high touch areas
- Encouraging masks to be worn as required
- Encouraging up to date vaccinations for our staff and students
- Maintaining natural ventilation
- Continue to provide RAT testing kits free of charge.

**Bus Transport:** Parents are able to access bus transport for students, info on the Transport website. Dave Smith's bus has an early bus run and a later run to accommodate children coming to Candelo PS.

**Library:** Each Wednesday the children will return and borrow books from the Library in class groups. Our endeavour is to create dynamic classrooms that fully support students on their literacy journeys and prepare them to become not just literate, knowledgeable citizens but also *lifelong readers*.
